Keeping you in the loop!

Hello everyone!

How are you all? We hope you are staying safe and keeping protected.

We are returning to the office this week but there are some changes. These include:

- On site days will be limited to two per week (until further notice)
- Limiting access to both of our buildings
- Anyone visiting either site will be asked to wear a face covering (unless medically exempt or under 11 years of age-proof may be requested)
- Staff will be wearing face masks or face coverings during face to face appointments
- Maximising the use of telephone and video meetings for appointments
- Door step collection for activity packs and community meals
- Hand sanitiser stations for use by all staff and visitors
- Use of plastic screens
- Ongoing suspension of hall hire



Please remember..... The new law around the wearing of face masks in indoor public spaces comes into law on the 8th August. New Heights will be implementing these new requirements as on Tuesday 4th August. This will remain in place until the government advises it is safe to work without face coverings.

Kerry's Comments:

Hello everyone!

We can confirm that we will be returning to the office buildings as of tomorrow. Due to social distancing requirements required to keep everyone safe, things will look different at New Heights until the Government further eases lockdown restrictions.

What can you expect in August?.....

☺ One project operating per building per day

St Johns centre holiday activities: Tuesday & Thursday

Breathe benefits & housing advice: Wednesday & Thursday

Counselling Service: Monday & Tuesday (resuming 1st September 2020)

☺ No access to either building without appointment and wearing of a face mask (unless medically exempt or under 11 years of age - evidence may be required)

☺ All staff will be wearing a face mask or shield whilst on site

☺ Weekly community meals to collect and take away (see front page)

☺ Youth Social Action activity & food packs to collect & take away (5 weeks)

☺ Ongoing suspension of hall hire to minimise risks

☺ Ongoing access to services via telephone and video call appointments

☺ Enquiries to be dealt with via telephone or email

☺ Implementation of new Covid-19 safe working practices (including hand sanitising Stations, use of screens and face shields and regular sanitisation of offices.

As lockdown restrictions are reviewed by the Government, we will continue to review our practices and restrictions. When we feel it is safe to do so, we will slowly start to reintroduce hall hire for the use of groups (such as Slimming World, Scouts, Lunch Club and Karate), increased on site days for all services and reopen the cafe. Due to the halt on the ease of restrictions announced on Friday 31st July, we are unable to say when further reopening is likely.
