The only remaining and preserved part of the road is located in Sutton Park. It is named on historic maps as Ickniel Street and is believed to have been built between 68-180 AD.

It runs for approximately 125 miles, from Gloucestershire to South Yorkshire, all being sites of major Roman encampment in England.

In 1909 two Roman coins were found close to the site.
